SUBJECT: DRAFT Spontaneous Volunteer Policy	DATE: May, 2011	

I. PURPOSE

To establish a policy for the use of spontaneous volunteers by PASART/CART during disasters and other deployable events.

II. <u>GOAL</u>

Establishes a uniform policy for the use of uncredentialed volunteers during disasters and related events.

III. <u>POLICY</u>

It is the policy of PASART to allow for limited use of spontaneous volunteers for disaster related activities when CARTs are deployed.

IV. <u>APPLICABILITY</u>

This policy applies to all PASART members and CART members.

V. PROCEDURES/REQUIREMENTS/RESTRICTIONS

1. PASART hereby approves and supports any CART which decides that it needs to utilize spontaneous volunteers during a deployable event.

If the CART decides to utilize spontaneous volunteers, the work assigned must be limited to tasks that do not require any animal rescue/sheltering/care training. Examples of such work include, but are not limited to:

- o Administrative tasks such as:
 - Storing, sorting, and filing paper files or computer files.
 - Preparing program materials, forms, brochures for distribution
- o Assisting experienced volunteers with their assigned tasks.

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- Select a volunteer who is a good delegator and suggest ways the spontaneous volunteer might help them.
- General administrative or housekeeping tasks (eg: cleaning animal crates while an experienced volunteer cares for the animal).
- 2. CARTs will obtain the following information:
 - Name (verified with ID such as driver's license or other form of photo ID)
 - o Qualifications
 - Contact information
 - How he/she learned about your organization
 - Emergency contact information
- **3.** CARTs will assign work that is relatively simple and under the supervision of an experienced volunteer.

4. <u>SPECIAL NOTE: Spontaneous volunteers who are PA Licensed</u> professionals (Veterinarians, Veterinary technicians) may be assigned tasks consistent with their licensure.

5. Attached questionnaire is to be used to collect necessary information from the spontaneous volunteer.
